





Lewdown Past

The Lewdown and area local history group

A History of Orchard Barton visit courtesy of William Yeo

Tuesday 19 June: 7.00 pm at Orchard Barton

Orchard Barton is an ancient farmhouse with features dating from the 17th century. Although some of its structure was apparently removed by Sabine Baring-Gould, its owner in the 19th century, and incorporated into Lew House, it still has many features of interest and is a Grade II listed building. The farm is also significant for being located on a packhorse trail, one of a network of ancient trackways which were often distinct from the wider drovers' roads.

Visitors are very welcome but are advised to register their interest, as above, in case there is a rare change of programme or for further information. Lifts are possible also, or you may wish to meet someone at Lewdown Post Office, by arrangement, for guidance to Orchard Barton. Charge £2 for members, £3 for non-members to include refreshments.

April Meeting: Our second visit to The Bude Canal explored what remains of the Devon sections of this canal. Operating between 1825 and 1891, the Bude Canal allowed 20ft-long wooden 'tub' boats to be towed by horses far inland, carrying beach sand to fertilise the acidic soils and anything else that was needed. One branch terminated at Holsworthy but all that remains of this are a few damp ditches, some converted wharf buildings and an occasional clue such as 'Canal Cottage'. The other Devon branch, starting at the Lower Tamar Lake, was known as the Bude aqueduct as it was originally only intended to act as a water supply for maintaining canal levels. However, just below this lake, a wharf was soon constructed at Virworthy. Here the basin is

still full of water (although it was a bit low, having sprung a leak!), a warehouse has been converted into a small museum and one of the original metal bridge frames is now a picnic table. It is possible to walk the towpath from the lake, past Virworthy and for about another five and a half miles to our next destination at Venn. Here we saw the junction with the Holsworthy branch and the site of filter beds dating from soon after the canal's closure when the water from the Tamar Lake was used to supplement Bude and Stratton's water supply. Only three locks were built at the wider, seaward end of the canal so that, to climb further inland, the wooden tub boats were fitted with wheels to enable them to be hauled up inclined planes on rails. We explored the most gently sloping inclined plane, crossed the upper reaches of the river Tamar into Cornwall on a solidly-built aqueduct and saw one of the few stone 'accommodation', or farm access, bridges over the canal. To finish, we revisited the spectacular, steep Hobbacott inclined plane, reputedly the longest on any English canal and had a distant view of Bude far below. Our leisurely day along the canal surely echoed the spirit and pace of a bye-gone age.
