

Illustrated talk by Sue Andrew

Stories on the Stones

***an insight on the lives of those
buried in Dartmoor's churchyards***

We are privileged to have yet another visit by the chair of the Devonshire Association, Dr Sue Andrew. Some epitaphs on gravestones have become well-known, through their quotation in newspapers and books, but few people have sought to uncover the human stories behind them. Sue's talk will shed light on the people remembered and those who sought to honour their resting places. I am sure she will have discovered some interesting characters.

Visitors are very welcome but may like to phone 01566 783396 nearer the time to check there has not been a rare change of programme or for further information. Lifts are possible also. Charge £2 for members, £3 for non-members to include refreshments.

At our October meeting, Alan Endacott told how, in 2007, a gorse fire led him to discover a stone circle that had been forgotten for thousands of years. Having studied Dartmoor's archaeology since childhood, he had noticed that stone circles formed an arc, or even a circle, around the slopes of the moor and predicted that there should be another circle near the double circles of Greywethers, on the moor above Chagford. After this fire, a result of swaling getting out of control, the shrivelled vegetation revealed a few stones, more were detected with a probe and, as a result of this exciting discovery, the national park authorities assisted in further clearance to reveal what is now known as the Sittaford stone circle. None of the stones remained upright, and dating of material found beneath them showed they fell (or were pushed) over at least 2000 years ago. As they are lying flat, possibly the best view of this circle is on Google earth, which is also a helpful guide to finding their location if you wish to visit!







Cathie then handed over to Peter van Delft, retired owner of West Devon Nurseries. Peter is the fourth generation in his family to be a nurseryman. His great grandfather and grandfather traded in Holland. His mother was the next in line and she worked with his father. They then moved to England after his father visited and loved it after he arranged to give one of his customers a 'tour' of English nurseries, despite not knowing any himself! His father was more of a salesman and he built the business up and Peter ran the nursery with him after attending college and expanding his training in Holland in the late 1970'S. The business was split into wholesale and retail with Peter taking over the nursery in Newton Abbott in 1985 through until 2014. Wholesale at that time was raising 'liners', which were supplied as either bare rooted plants or in sacks rather than pots. 'Liners' or small starter plants had to achieve a technical standard of so many shoots on the lower stem of the plant and these were sold in five sizes. Peter explained they grew 1.6 million plants and propagated a further 440k plants each year, which they sold mainly north of Birmingham but also abroad to places like France, Germany and Russia. Propagation can be done a number of ways. A lot are done with tiny leaf tissue suspended in agar in sterile laboratories. Here one tiny leaf bud can produce thirty shoots in just two weeks and they are guaranteed to be exact replicas of the mother plant and disease free. Walkers crisps propagate all of their potato plants this way.

Barbara gave the VOT thanking Peter for sharing such a wide range of knowledge and making all the methods he demonstrated look very easy. It was a thoroughly educational and entertaining evening.
