

#### There are three simple actions we must all do to keep on protecting each other



Wash hands keep washing your hands regularly

**Cover face** wear a face covering in enclosed spaces

### NHS

If you have any coronavirus symptoms:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste

Get a test and stay at home

Make space stay at least 2 metres apart—or 1 metre with a face covering or other precautions

Remember, whatever Tier we end up in after the Christmas and New Year period, the following guidance applies across all tiers, everyone:

- must wear a face covering in most indoor public settings, unless they have an exemption
- should follow the <u>rules on meeting others safely</u>
- should attend school or college as normal, unless they are selfisolating. Schools, universities, colleges and early years settings remain open in all tiers
- should walk or cycle where possible, plan ahead and avoid busy times and routes when travelling
- must follow the gathering limits at their tier except for in specific settings and circumstances.
- Everyone who can work from home should do so.







From the Parish Priest

Dear friends,

By the time you are reading this, you will be in the middle of your family and community Christmas celebrations. I do hope that they are all going to plan and are suitably joyful!

But this is the January Edition, and so it is about January that I should write. We know that as soon as Christmas Day is over, the High Street, or now perhaps I would be better saying the Online Shopping world, quickly removes all vestiges of Christmas, whether they be decorations or canned music, and move on.

What many people forget is that Christmas does not last just for one, or even 12 days. Like many of the other major seasons of the church's year it lasts for 40 days, and includes within it two other major festivals. The Feast of the Epiphany is kept on the  $6^{th}$  January.
