From The Parish Priest

I would like to thank all those who enabled us to hold our thanksgiving services across the Mission Community during the period of National Morning, and to all of you who supported them.

It seems very appropriate that I write about the death of her majesty as we prepare for the end of the Church's year when we think of the culmination and perfection of all things in the perfect Kingdom of God. 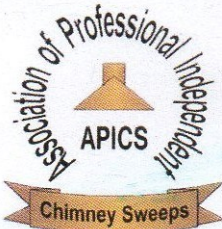

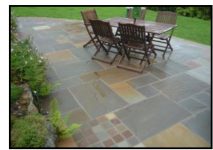
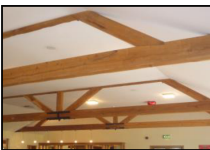
