

There cannot be a single person who has not had a conversation about the cost of living crisis which seems to be escalating at an alarming rate and this month's question is typical of the thousands of requests we get each month asking for help and advice.

"The cost of energy and food is so high now. With the kids home from school for the summer, I'm having to pay more for lunches and snacks. I'm worried about how I'll put food on the table. I'm on a prepayment meter and I'm really scared we're going to be left without any gas or electric if I can't top up. What can I do?"

As a prepayment meter customer, your energy supplier will be able to give you temporary credit if you can't afford to top up your meter. They might add this to your meter automatically, but if they don't, you can call them and ask them to do this.

If you run out of temporary credit, speak to your supplier and explain your situation. They may give you extra temporary credit if you are struggling with living costs. If you're disabled, have a long term health condition or you have children under 5 you may also qualify to get extra credit. You'll have to pay back anything extra you get, but you can agree how to do this in a way you can afford.

CA TNMWD are working with Devon County Council to manage an Energy Relief Scheme and it could be that you qualify for fuel vouchers. We also have a specially trained Energy Advice Team who will provide free, confidential and informed advice. Either visit www.ruraldevoncab.org.uk click on 'Get Advice' then go to the Energy tab. Alternatively, ring our free, local AdviceLine on

0808 27 87 999. You may like to consider having a Smart Meter installed (at no cost to you) and this is something else out team can advise on.

There is more government support coming in October to help with energy bills including a £400 payment. With a prepayment meter you will be given vouchers in the first week of each month from October.

If you pay council tax and are in bands A-D you may have already received a payment of £150 which is being automatically credited by local councils. If you haven't and you qualify, check out your council's website and see how you go about making a claim.

You may find it useful to check out www.citizensadvice.org.uk where we Page 14

have benefits calculators you can use online to assess whether you are eligible to claim anything and there is also advice on how to reduce living costs and other ways to increase your income.

School holidays put additional pressures on everyone's budget. Contact your local council to see if there is extra support available to help you over the holiday period. At CA TNMWD we can also help you get a referral for a food bank voucher. You are by no means the only person in your situation so just reach out to us for help. www.ruraldevoncab.org.uk or 0808 27 87 999.

We give ongoing training and support and you would be helping us to meet the ever increasing demands on our services!

From The Parish Priest

Dear friends,

As I write this letter, I am sorting out all the arrangements for the celebration of Harvest Thanksgiving across our churches.

Since Victorian times, the celebration of the Harvest in the Autumn has become part of our annual pattern of events. The Farmers sow, nurture and reep. We then thank God for his gifts.

The harvest, or lack of, has been a major news item over the past few weeks. A combination of the hot weather, lack of rainfall, and other world events such as the war in Ukraine has meant that the world faces a shortage of food, and the inevitable rise in the cost of food for the customers in the shops.

I read in an information leaflet this year that approximately, worldwide, One Third of all the food grown prepared, packaged and cooked for human use is thrown away before it is eaten. **And yet** there are still millions of people who are starving in this world. This is a disgraceful situation, and something that all of us can do something about, not only by lobbying those who make policy and decisions, but also in the way we manage our own households.

Thanking God for his gifts in Creation does not mean taking them for granted.

This harvest, let us think again of the effort that goes into providing our food, and the real human cost of wasting the earth's valuable resources.

 - Gifts £226.15, Cllr A. Harrop refund for materials used for repair of noticeboard £79.84, Lewdown Victory Hall
 - Committee hall hire £250.00, Cllr T Southcott refund for emergency plan equipment £707.48, P. van Delft clerk salary (June- July) £333.88, HMRC PAYE £72.20
 - 5.2 R.F.O. reported a credit balance after payments of £20,194.13 5.3 WDBC Localities grant of £500 for the jubilee events to be applied for by the clerk
- 6. Reports from councillors Cllr Wilkinson reported that some trees have been identified with Ash Dieback in Stoney Lane; also, it appears that the dog waste bin near the Blue Lion has been very well used, possibly no collection has been made as scheduled, Cllr Wilkinson to report problem to the waste contractors. Cllr Andrews thanked everyone for their support and help in making the Queens Jubilee celebrations held in June a great success.
- 7. WDBC Cllr Mott. Reported that a Community Fund grant was now available for voluntary groups and parish councils.


